**Dewey.** Dewey, who?

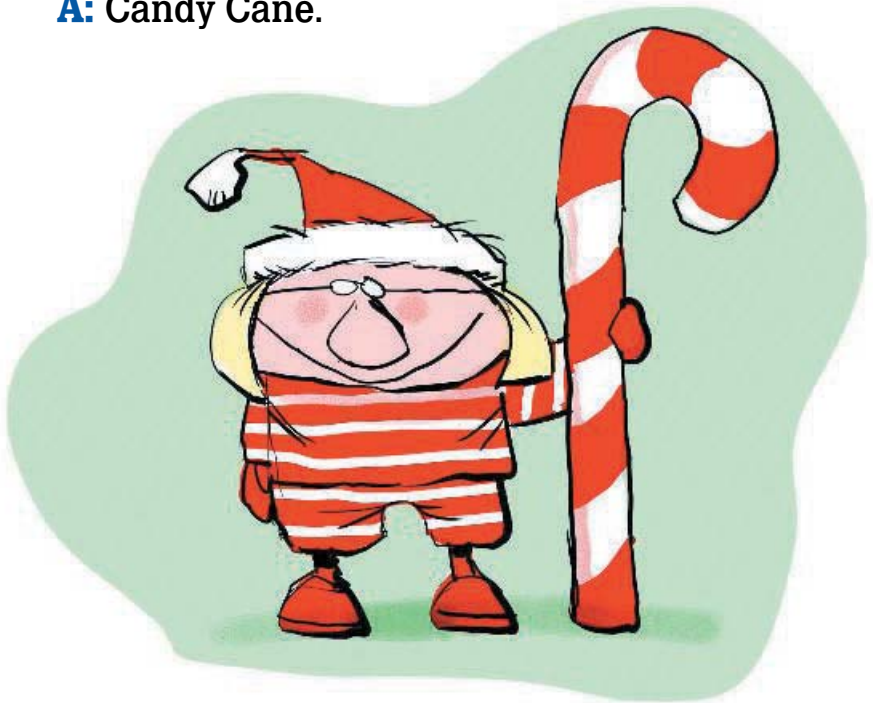
**Dewey have to go to school today?**

**Hugo.** Hugo, who?

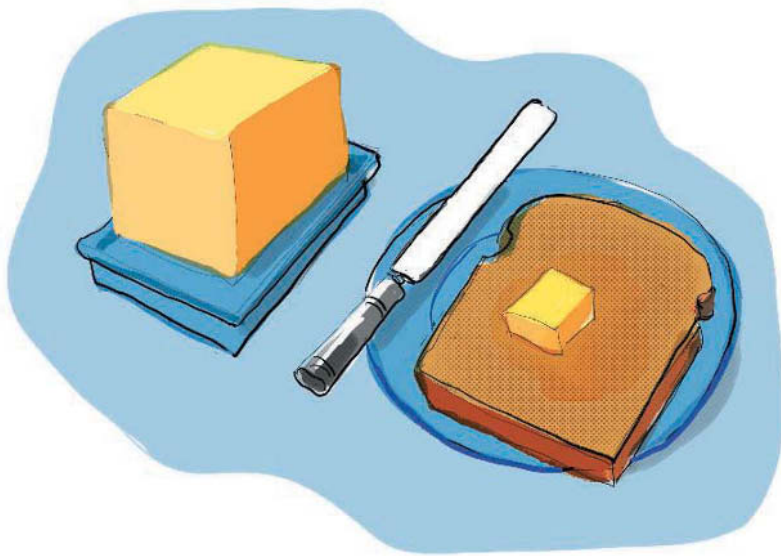
**Hugo to the head of the class.**

**Rhoda.** Rhoda, who?

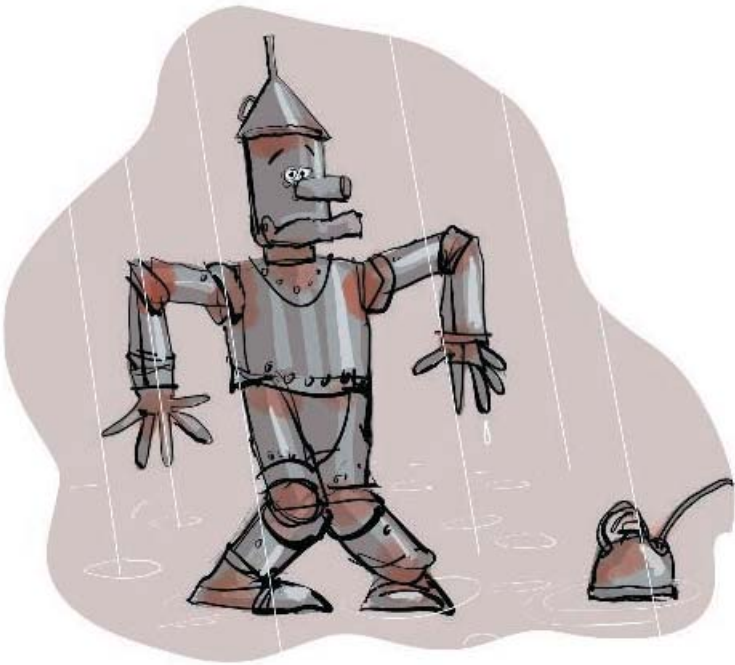
**Rhoda horse yesterday and fell off.**
